^{*} Attendance condonation fee is to be given by the candidates with attendance below 80% up to 50% in Theory papers and 90% up to 50% in Practicum papers. Candidates with attendance below 50% in any of the Theory papers /Practicum papers are not eligible for appearing at the examination.

Note:

- An amount of Rs. 200/- per candidate is to be retained by the college for meeting up the expenditure of Practical Examination including
 remuneration and conveyance of External Examiner as prescribed by the University. Rs. 600/- (Rs.800/- Rs. 200/-) per candidate is to be
 paid by the college to the University along with the filled in examination forms. The total amount of examination fee is to be paid by the
 college through bank draft in favour of WBUTTEPA EXAM payable at Kolkata.
- Spot payment of remuneration and TA is to be made to the External Examiner by the college.
- Hospitality and contingencies for the practical examination are to be met up from the retained fund.
- The Practical Examination Fee retained at the college over the expenditure met up for the remuneration, conveyance and hospitality will have to be equally distributed to the Internal Evaluators.
- An utilisation certificate of the fund retained at the college for the practical examination along with the copies of vouchers will have to be submitted to the Controller of Examinations immediately after the completion of the Examination.

Rate of Remuneration and TA of External Examiner for Practical Examination

1. Remuneration

Rs.2500/- (consolidated) per day for conducting practical examination at a college irrespective of number of candidates. Practical Examination for one Unit (maximum 50 students) is to be completed in one day, for two Units (maximum 100 students) in two days, for three Units (maximum 150 students) in three days and for four Units (maximum 200 students) to be completed in four days.

2. T.A

T.A. is to be provided to the External Examiner as the actual fare incurred by him or her either from the serving institution or from his / her residence. Journey by car / taxi/ train (Up to AC 2 tier) is admissible, provided the valid tickets / receipts are to be produced.
