
*Attendance condonation fee is to be given by the candidates with attendance below 80% up to 50% in Theory papers and 90% up to 50% in Practicum papers. Candidates with attendance below 50% in any of the Theory papers/ Practicum papers are not eligible for appearing at the examination.

NOTE:

- An amount of **Rs.200/-** per candidate to be retained by the college for meeting up the expenditure of Practical Examination including remuneration and conveyance of External Examiner as prescribed by the University. **Rs.600/-** (Rs.800/- - Rs.200/-) per candidate is to be paid by the college to the University along with the filled in examination forms. The total amount of examination fee is to be paid by the college through bank draft in favour of **WBUTTEPA** payable at Kolkata.
- Spot payment of remuneration and TA is to be made to the External Examiner.
- Hospitality and contingencies for the practical examination is to be met up from the retained fund.

Rate of Remuneration and TA of External Examiner for Practical Examination

1. Remuneration : Rs. 50/- per student for all the items of Practicum, but minimum remuneration will be Rs. 2000/-.
Practical Examination for one Unit of 50 students is to be completed in one day.
2. T. A. : T.A. is to be provided to the External Examiner as the actual fare incurred by him or her either from the serving institution or from his/ her residence. Journey by car / taxi / train (up to AC 2 tier) is admissible. If journey is made by train with reservation, the valid ticket is to be produced.
